



יִשָּׂא הִי פָנָיו אֵלֶיךָ וַיַּשֵּׂם לְךָ שְׁלוֹם.


*Y'varekh'kha Adonai v'yishm'rekha.

Todah Rabbah - We appreciate you!




Finally, we bless the wine and the bread:

לֶחֶם מִן הָאָרֶץ.


*Barukh ata Adonai, eloheinu melek ha-olam hamotzi
